



Beaches and islands of the Eastern Algarve: (outside the peak season, reduced ferry service!) - *t t = travel time

- 1) Between Vila Real and Manta Rota (beginning of Ria Formosa) there are the beaches directly accessible by car
- 2) Cabanas – east of the promenade takes off the ferry, crossing the lagoon to the Atlantic: t t: ca. 5 min.
- 3) Ilha de Tavira – takes off near the old fresh market or from “Quatro Águas” (on the edge of the town)
- 4) Pedras d’el Rei – crossing a bridge you will reach the Atlantic, or go by a tiny train to the beach “Barril”
- 4a) Santa Luzia – takes off every 30 minutes from the promenade to the beach “Terra Estreita” - t t: ca. 10 min.
- 5) Ilha de Fuseta – takes off in Fuseta runs regularly to the island. Travel time: ca. 10 min.
- 5a) In the town of Fuseta, there is a little sandy beach in the lagoon, ideal for children
- 6) Ilha da Armona - a ferry takes off every hour from Olhão (east of the promenade). t t: 20 min. + by foot ca. 15 min.
- 7) Ilha da Culatra und Farol - a ferry takes off from Olhão to the amazing beaches (ca. Every 2 hours) - t t: ca. 30 min.
- 8) Ilha de Faro - before reaching the airport, is a road going straight to the island, you have to pass a bridge for cars.
- 9) At Quinta do Lago ends the nature reserve of Ria Formosa, here are again many accesses going to the beaches.
